First start: 10:00 AM  
Time limit: 120 min  
Start interval: 2 min  
Prestart area: enter 4 min prior start

Map: 1:10 000 / 5 m, A4 (slightly less), portrait, not water-proofed, overprinted with all controls and crossed-out according to category, will be distributed after start

Start corridor: approx 100 m, only one  
Finish corridor: approx 100 m

Marking device: be aware — there is neither flag nor red/white tape

**What's foxoring?** ... See International Rules F1.

Map has overprinted positions of start, finish, and nominal positions of transmitters. Transmitters are placed somewhere close, operating continuously on low power (audible at tens up to a one or two hundred meters). Competitor navigates using a map to the nominal position and then searches for transmitter. There is no flag, just SI station.
